



What to bring:

Light quiet camoflaue clothing
Good hunting/hiking boots
Binoculars
Light rain gear
Camera
Weapon that has been sighted 1 inch high at 100 yds
1 box of shells
Small day pack
2 large coolers if transporting meat and hide (if you want your own taxidermist)

Where to meet:

Our guides do all the driving and will pick you up at your lodging facility. Please call or text the night before to let us know you have arrived and your guide will come down and talk over the outline of the hunt.

Hunting license and tag:

Special permits:

Rayonier General hunt permits are for access to private timber company lands and available at <http://www.rayonierhunting.com/> You may purchase the GENERAL HUNT INDIVIDUAL or FAMILY permit depending on the number in your hunting party. Unit specific permits are optional.
